

April 2017 Sightings Report

It was a very warm, wet April, the 5th warmest on record, with temperatures averaging 51.5 °F, 5.2° above normal. Yet there was only one high temperature record tied, with 86° on the 27th. It was the 4th wettest April on record, with 4.95" of rain, 2.22" above normal. Much of this was due to major rain events of over 1" in the periods 6-7, 20, & 30 April. The number of days with measurable precipitation overall was right on the average of 13 days. The 2-month period of March & April ended up the 2nd wettest on record, with 10.74" (only 1991 was wetter). The only cold period was the 6th-7th, when all the 2.5" of snowfall for the month arrived. Most of the month's storms and rainfall arrived from the Ohio Valley. The birding picture was affected by the long periods of north or east winds and wet weather with only brief drier spells. But birds arrived with the gaps in the weather or otherwise trickled in, and the many observers reported a near record number of species and some interesting finds.

Again, all the expected waterfowl were recorded. Also again, by late in the month the numbers of lingering birds were very low, a continuing trend. Peak numbers for most species were low, as illustrated in the maxima in the Noteworthy Sightings table. A rash of later good counts in the NMWMA (Northern Montezuma Wildlife Management Area) (Savannah mucklands) was occasioned by some rarities there attracting a large number of observers with the usual "Patagonia Rest Stop Effect". Loon and grebe peak counts were low. The highlights of the month included: lingering male Eurasian Wigeons, a "Eurasian" Green-winged Teal, and a female Harlequin Duck.

The hawk watch recorded a good month, with some very good days. Broad-winged Hawk, Turkey Vulture, Sharp-shinned Hawk, and Red-tailed Hawk accounted for most of the birds. There were also good numbers of eagles, and the first Black Vulture of the year passed. There were 10 days with totals over 1000 birds, one more day than last year.

Shorebird variety was again POOR and numbers very low. Water levels were high across the region. There were puddles and pools in the fields, but maybe too many and mostly empty. The Martin Road (Hamlin) field hosted a few shorebirds, including a record early Willet, but it was often pumped dry. Fields like south of Carncross Road in the NMWMA were flooded but mainly devoid of birds. The main spot for birds was the NMWMA (Savannah mucklands) where a Black-necked Stilt (the second record for our region when it strayed north a few hundred yards into Wayne County) attracted loads of birders, with Eurasian Wigeon, "Eurasian" Teal, good numbers of several species of waterfowl, American White Pelican, several other shorebird species, and two Little Gulls also found there. Gull and tern numbers were again generally low, but large numbers of Caspian Terns arrived late in the month, and the usual late Iceland, Lesser Black-backed, and Glaucous Gulls were located. Two other adult Little Gulls were seen along the lakeshore.

The owl counting at the "Owl Woods" area on Manitou Beach Road had a high-average month, with 21 Long-eared and 24 Northern Saw-whet Owls tallied. Short-eared Owl counts by the DEC continued through April 26, but with no owls seen on that last date. A few Eastern Whip-poor-wills arrived early. Another candidate for bird of the month was an adult male Rufous Hummingbird at a feeder above Hemlock Lake, unfortunately with the situation such that number of visitors was very limited. This is a 4th record for the region and first in spring.

The Braddock Bay Bird Observatory banding effort was off to a fairly slow start, with about 2/3 of the birds banded either Black-capped Chickadee (an "up" year) or kinglets. There were 10 species reported at "record early" dates relative to the old Monroe County Checklist, but only the Yellow Warbler seen at Ganondagon on the 16th was really record early. There were 16 species of warblers reported (one less than last year), again most of those arriving in the last few days of the month. Given the conditions, one might expect low counts, and that generally was the case. But if you look at the Noteworthy Sightings table you will see that people taking the time to go to the "right" places at good dates and under good conditions were able to tally some really good numbers for passing migrants, e.g.: 3650 Blue Jays on the 28th, 1,260 Tree and 850 Barn Swallows on the 27th, 410 Yellow-rumped Warblers on the 28th, 2,160 Rusty Blackbirds on the 10th, 1,500 Brown-headed Cowbirds on the 10th, and 704 Purple Finches on the 27th. There were no especially rare passerine records with sufficient details supplied. Winter finches included only a lone Common Redpoll, a few Pine Siskins, and a few passing Evening Grosbeaks. The non-passerine Eurasian Collared-Dove in Hamlin was not reported this month.

This month there were about 45,800 eBird records submitted and 10% or so additional records from other sources.
