

## September 2016 Sightings Report

This month continued along the lines of the warm hot summer, with just a bit more rainfall and a few short cool periods. The month started cool, but by the 5<sup>th</sup> was back into the 80's. Fourteen more days above 80 °F in the month brought the year to a new record high 95 days. A high of only 64° on the 24<sup>th</sup> broke a string of 102 consecutive days with highs above 70°. Temperatures averaged 66.8°, 5.0° above normal. It was the 9<sup>th</sup> warmest September on record. Rainfall totaled 2.30", 1.08" below normal, and 1.76" of that fell with the passage of a storm system on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. In the final week of the month, a weak upper level low brought some cooling and light rain showers. Fronts were few, and migration was weak through much of the month.

Waterfowl numbers remained relatively poor for nearly all species through the month, but arrivals trickled in for many of the diving ducks and the loons and grebes, some at early dates. Counts of 158 Northern Pintails and 105 Red-breasted Mergansers were good for this early, and Common Loon reached 105 birds on the 27<sup>th</sup>. The increase of Double-crested Cormorants in Irondequoit Bay this summer is the likely source for several counts of > 1000 along the lakeshore to the west this month. There were good counts of 92 Great Egrets and 45 Black-crowned Night-Herons in the Morgan Road area of the Northern Montezuma Wildlife Management Area (NMWMA).

Among the raptors, there was no concerted effort at monitoring the end of the summer hawk flight past Braddock Bay, but Dave Tetlow caught a decent count of 137 Red-tailed Hawks on the 8<sup>th</sup>. Interestingly, two Northern Goshawks were both reported on the 15<sup>th</sup> in Greece and Webster Park. Both Merlin and Peregrine Falcons were reported in very good numbers.

Shorebird variety was good, with 26 species reported. Only Upland Sandpiper was missing among those really expected, with Red Knot always rare. Peak numbers were relatively low, though, 36 Sanderlings is a good count for recent years. Rarer species included a Willet, Whimbrel, Buff-breasted Sandpiper, and Western Sandpiper. With the dry summer and lake levels still high, many of the records came from the Morgan Road Marshes in the NMWMA.

No jaegers or rare gulls or terns this month! About 8 Lesser Black-backed Gull reports is typical of recent

years. There were only single reports of Black and Forster's Terns at Hamlin Beach and Sodus Point, respectively.

Moving to the non-passerine land birds, we start with another report of Eurasian Collared-Dove from the Greenwell farm in Hamlin. Among the owls, reports of both Long-eared and Northern Saw-whet Owls from North Wolcott in Wayne County are unusual for the time of year, though both are considered resident. Common Nighthawk was not very well reported, though a count of 43 is fairly high for recent years. There still is a general request for fall monitoring of Chimney Swift, but numbers reported locally this month were poor, with a maximum of 38.

Again this month, essentially all of the expected passerines were reported. The only "misses" were rarer birds or ones that require special effort to search out or are always touch and go for either lingering into this month or arriving before the end of the month. The Noteworthy Records table to be posted on the RBA website will contain a number of samples of numbers banded to illustrate numbers and species that are up and down. Again this month, there were no really great banding days, with the highest total being 145 birds on the 25<sup>th</sup>. But as last year, the numbers were steady, and totals not far off typical. Details are online at the BBBO website, both a banding table and daily notes are available. Numbers banded for Red-eyed Vireo, Gray-cheeked and Swainson's thrushes, Magnolia Warbler and Blackpoll Warbler were very good. Passerine rarities for the month included: banded White-eyed Vireo and two Bicknell's Thrushes, a Connecticut Warbler seen and photographed at Beatty Point, and a Clay-colored Sparrow found on the Montezuma Muck Race on September 17. Four Olive-sided Flycatcher reports is also a good number for recent years. Fall arrival and departure dates noted this month were all within their known distributions for the region.
